- 1 21 Nov 1986 Lothian Regional Council – Co-ordinated Programme in Response to Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome. Papers proposing the secondment of an officer to act as AIDS co-ordinator. Written by R G Musgrave, Director of Management and Information Services.
- 2 25 Nov 1986 Lothian Regional Council – Note of points agreed/raised at meeting. The meeting was to agree wording for a report to Council on the co-ordinated programme in response to AIDS.
- 3 c1987 Lothian Regional Council – Policy and Resources Committee – AIDS Policy Statement.
- 4 c1987 Lothian Regional Council – Employment Policy on AIDS.
- 5 c1987 Guidelines of the Regional AIDS Group on making recommendations to Trusts about the allocation of funds in Lothian. Paper numbered for submission to a committee meeting.
- 6 Jan 1987 – Jun 1987 Papers relating to Taylor's appointment as HIV/AIDS Co-ordinator. Includes job description; formal notification to Taylor of his secondment; and current work projects.
- 7 Nov 1987 – Jan 1989 Papers relating to the further development of Taylor's role as AIDS Co-ordinator. Includes job description; salary grading.
- 8 Mar 1989 Letter and council resolution concerning the appointment of Taylor to the management committee of the Gateway Exchange Project.
- 9 Apr 1989 – Jan 1992 Correspondence and papers relating to Taylor's secondment to the post of AIDS Co-ordinator. Includes evaluation of the role of co-ordinator during 1988/9; current work issues in February and June 1990; letter by Dr Bath, Consultant in Public Health Medicine in support of the AIDS Co-ordinator's role.
- 10 Jan 1992 Services for Sex Industry Workers in Lothian – a report by the HIV/AIDS Management Team Specialist Sub-Group. Report by David Taylor, Chair of the Sub Group on Sex Industry in Lothian.
