Hugh Gilmour was a senior lecturer in Pathology at the University of Edinburgh Medical School. Although these are his personal papers, many of them seem to have originated from committees of which he was a member or are official publications.

- 1 Dec 1964 University of Edinburgh - Report of Sub-Committee on the Structure and Policy of Post-Graduate Education
- 2 1965 University of Edinburgh - Introduction to the Faculty of Medicine
- 3 Sep 1975 - 1991 File originally titled 'Minutes and Agenda - Area Div Lab Med Exec' [Area Divisional Laboratory Medical Executive]. Contains constitution of Advisory Group in Laboratory Medicine, 9/1975 and subsequent agenda and minutes; report on Medical Contribution to Institutional Management – Royal Infirmary of Edinburgh, 1/1977; constitution of the Division of Laboratory Medicine and Allied Sciences, 3/1976 and subsequent agenda of meetings; constitution and membership lists for the Area Division of Laboratory Medicine and subsequent minutes; membership lists of Area Scientific Services Advisory Committee; discussion of the medical advisory structure.
- 4 Nov 1982 – Jun 1999 Medical and Scientific Staffing of National Health Service Pathology Departments. Published by Royal College of Pathologists. Reports are dated November 1982, April 1992 and June 1999.
- 5 May 1988 – Feb 1997 File originally titled 'Lab Med Acute Services Strategy'. Contains papers relating to provision and review of laboratory services; competitive tendering; Health Board's financial difficulties; rationalisation of pathology services. Separated from the rest of the file by a divider marked 'general' are minutes of Area Division of Laboratory Medicine meetings concerning Acute Services Strategy laboratory requirements.
- 6 Mar 1990 – Mar 1991 Titled 'Vaughan Ruckley's Pressure Group'. Ruckley circulated a letter to all Edinburgh consultants concerning the implications of Lothian Health Board's policies. Contains correspondence; copy of the letter sent to the newspapers; newspaper article; and list of consultants.
