

Annie Nicolson trained as a nurse at Craiglockhart Hospital, qualifying in 1921. Her training covered medical and surgical nursing, anatomy and physiology, hygiene and dietetics and midwifery. She went on to work at Seafield Hospital, Leith. Acc 09/13 – AS 1/2011.
