

GD1/4/ NOTES FROM LECTURES BY WILLIAM PULTENEY ALISON

The lecture notes were taken by an unknown student from lectures on the Institutes of Medicine by William Pulteney Alison, Professor of the Institutes of Medicine at the University of Edinburgh, 1821-1842, and Professor of Medicine at the University of Edinburgh, 1842-1855.

The notes fall into two groups, those dated 24 Nov-19 Dec 1828 and those dated 2-23 Dec 1830. Both sets of notes relate to the circulation of properties of the blood. Alison summarised his lectures in *Outlines of Physiology*, 1831 and *Outlines of Physiology and Pathology* 1833.
