These papers were transferred to the Medical Archive Centre in 1982 by the Archivist of Greater Glasgow Health Board, to whom they had been given by Mrs MW Menzies-Campbell, a niece of the Millers. They relate mainly to the medical education of the Millers in Edinburgh. Dr Ada Miller graduated MB.ChB in 1914.
