Introduction

Dr Haldane Philip Tait MD, FRCP (Edin.), FFCM, DPH (1911-1990) was the Principal Medical Officer for the Child Health Service, Edinburgh and helped found the Scottish Society of the History of Medicine(SSHM) in 1948 at the Royal College of Surgeons in Edinburgh. As the first Secretary of the Society he was in charge of its organisation and held the position for fifteen years, before becoming a joint Secretary for several years after that. He was awarded the title 'Honorary President of the Society' in 1981 and it now holds an annual 'Haldane Tait Memorial' lecture and dinner in honour of him.

His most significant contribution to the Society was the Annual Report of Proceedings which, in later years, was published for international distribution to libraries and similar organisations to the SSHM. When it could not be published as such, a succinct version was issued in *Medical History*.

His interests in the history of medicine lead him to publish a number of articles and books. These include *A Doctor and Two Policemen*. (Edinburgh: Mackenzie and Storrie Ltd, 1974), which details the history of the Edinburgh Health Department from its creation in 1862 to its dissolution in 1974, and *Dr Elsie Maud Inglis (1864-1917): a great lady doctor*. (Edinburgh: Bridgend Press, 1964).

The collection has been retained in the original order (though within each sub-fonds items are listed and labelled chronologically) it was received in, with exception of the press cuttings which have been divided into three sub-fonds that Tait seemed to have intended them to be in. These groupings were apparent from a numbering system that he had used of which there is further explanation at sub-fonds 8-10.
