Introduction

In 1874 the Edinburgh Association for Incurables was founded. In 1903 it received a Royal Charter and became known as the Royal Edinburgh Hospital for Incurables.

In February 1875 Longmore Hospital was opened and in 1906 a second hospital was opened at Liberton. The two together were known as The Royal Edinburgh Hospital for Incurables.

The Hospital was set up to cater for people presumed to be incurable and in need of constant medical supervision. Such patients were unable to receive attention at the Royal Infirmary which did not have the facilities to look after long term cases.

In 1948, with the setting up of the NHS the Hospital became part of the Southern Hospital Group Board of Management.

1 Managers' Minutes, 1947-1950

These Minutes record the Managers' administration of the Hospital. They include reports of the various committees, financial matters concerning each of Longmore and Liberton, management of other properties owned by the hospital, the problem of waiting lists for admission, and recruitment drives for nurses.

1 1947-1950 This volume spans the introduction of the Health Service, but the remit of the Managers remains unchanged.

2 Annual Reports, 1875-1948

The Annual Reports include reports by the Managers, the Medical Officers and the Auditors. They give details of maintenance costs for patients, amounts of donations and collections received, and results of appeals. Also given are regulations for admission of patients and notes as to cases suitable for admission.

Bound volumes giving date of admission; name, address and age of each patient; name and address of next of kin; ward; rate of board; diagnosis; date of death or discharge; and reason for discharge.

2	1955-1962	Longmore Hospital – Patients Register – Chronic Patients – 1 st Jan 1955. Includes patients admitted before 1955 and still in the hospital on 1 st January 1955. The earliest admission recorded is June 1916.
