Introduction

Herdmanflat Hospital was built in 1866 by the East Lothian County Council and known in its early history as the Haddington or East Lothian District Asylum. In 1948 the Hospital was transferred to the Board of Management for Rosslynlee and Haddington Mental Hospitals. This Board of Management was dissolved in 1957 and Herdmanflat Hospital was transferred to the East Lothian Board of Management. The Vert Memorial Hospital, previously a maternity unit, was converted in 1973 for use as a psycho-geriatric annexe.

The majority of the fonds is from Acc 04/04. Where an item is from Acc 04/26a it has been indicated in the entry.

These have been arranged chronologically.

1 Asylum Registers of Lunatics, 1866-1993

Each register entry includes the date of admission, the name of the patient, sex, age, whether pauper or private, place of abode, bodily condition, form of mental disorder and date of discharge. Not indexed.

2 Case Books, 1866-1915

The volumes are for both males and females and each one is indexed. Each entry gives the patient's name, date of admission, initial diagnosis and progress and are cross referred to the registers at LHB47/1/1. The volumes are pre-printed from Vol.5.

The volumes contained enclosures which have been housed separately according to the page number they relate to. Where there are enclosures for a case, the letters "Encl" have been pencilled at the top corner of the relevant page. The enclosures should be requested at the same time as the volume. It should be noted though that the enclosures do not necessarily relate to the case on the page.

Registers of Death, 1867-1976

Each register gives the date of death, the date of last admission, name of the patient, cause of death and age.

4 Register of Discharge and Removals, 1867-1920

The register gives the name of the patient, date of last admission, date of discharge, authority on which discharge made, where sent, person into whose care the patient was sent and observations.

5 Register of Probation, 1867-1969

The register gives the name of the patient, the length of time they have been insane, the date of their removal, to whom sent (ie to whose care were they given during the probationary period), length of trial and result.

1 18 Jun 1867 – 7 Feb 1969 In very poor condition.

6 Register of Restraint and Seclusion, 1868-1964

The register gives the name of the patient, form and duration of restraint and name of superintendent. It also includes loose forms titled 'quarterly excerpts from the register of restraint and seclusion' at the front of the volume, one of which was used in 1946, the rest being blank.

7 Register of Voluntary Patients, 1872-1961

Gives the name of the patient, date of admission, date of discharge and in most cases the reason for discharge. Includes names at rear of patients who have been changed to informal status.

8 Case Book (Post Mortems), 1904-1919

This register gives the post mortem results for individual patients. Not indexed.

9 Certification Papers, 1917-1958

These are arranged in bundles by certification number. The certificate is in the form of a petition to the Sheriff to allow the admission of a patient, gives extensive patient details and two medical certificates.

10 Register of Escapes, 1928-1966

Gives the name of the patient, date of admission, date of escape, mode of escape and date of return.

11 Registers of Physical Condition, 1930-1956

Gives the name of the patient, date of admission, date of examination (usually the same day) and a brief description of the patient's condition.

12 <u>List of Transfers from Bangour Mental Hospital, 1939</u>

Alphabetical list of patients transferred giving their names, age, religion, date of admission, next of kin and brief details.

13 EEG Day Book, 1953-1958

Gives the EEG number, the patient's name, age, doctor referring, reason for referral and features of special interest. Includes statistics on totals at rear.

14 Register of Next of Kin, 1950s

Gives the name of the patient and their age, date of admission, religion, marital status, county, employment, next of kin and address of relatives. Although the book includes patients with admission dates back to 1903, the information was probably compiled at the time of the later entries c1958.

15 Admissions Book, 1977-1980

Gives hospital number, name, book number, date of admission and date of discharge. Not indexed.

Each day also has a blank page for a supplementary record and diary of occurrences.

1 Register of Attendants, 1868-1960

The front of the volume gives the details of the recruitment of attendants and the rear gives details of their leaving. The recruitment section, dated 1868-1948, gives the date of the start of employment, the attendant's name, their occupation at the Hospital and their wages. The leaving section, dated 1871-1960, gives the date the attendant left, their name, a cross reference to the front of the volume and the reason for leaving.

Gives the member of staff's name, date they started employment, address and their job title. It is arranged alphabetically by surname.
