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Introduction

The Eastern General Hospital was built in 1906 by the Leith Parish Council as a combined poor house and hospital. During the First World War the Hospital was used by the military authorities, becoming a base for injured US and Canadian troops. Later, a nurses' home, nurses' dining room and operating theatre were added. Following the Local Government Act 1929, the Hospital came under the control of the Edinburgh Corporation and was used as a hospital for the chronic sick. During the Second World War improvements were made to enable it to become part of the emergency hospital scheme.

Parts of the Hospital started to be closed from the late 1990s with the final closure coming in 2007. In 2008 the remaining Hospital buildings were badly damaged by fire.

A note inside the front cover of LHB48/1/2/1/1 states that the General Surgical Unit of the Hospital opened on 1 April 1961 and includes a list of senior staff. From volumes 1-9, the books give patient's index number, patient's name, age, admission date, operation date, type of anaesthetic, surgeon, type of operation and remarks. From volume 10 the information given is patient's index number, date of operation, patient's name, age, disease, type of operation, type of anaesthetic, operator (surgeon) and anaesthetist.

Volumes 2 and 3 and volumes 4 to 11 are in different formats from the first volume and each other but give virtually the same information although they include theatre number.

7 Registers of Deliveries, 1976-1998

The registers give the patient's name and address, age and case number; estimated delivery date; parity (number of children patient already had); date and time of actual delivery; whether labour 'S' or 'I'(possibly spontaneous or induced) ; presentation at delivery; method of delivery; analgesia or anaesthesia; complications; and delivered by (staff member). They also include collated statistical information on the reverse of the final page for each year.

1 <u>Maternity reports, 1952-1959</u>

These reports were a requirement of the Standard Maternity Hospital Report Committee of the Royal College of Obstetricians and Gynaecologists and consist of pre-printed tables. They captured statistical information on various obstetric conditions, stillbirths, premature live births, neonatal infections etc. No patient details are given except a register number which would presumably cross-refer to a patient register entry if patient registers were still extant.
